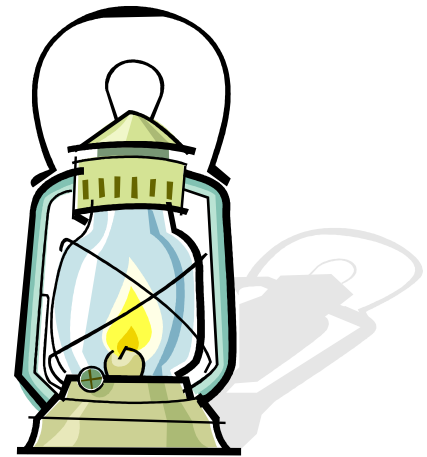

Dear West Highland Family,

*“You are the light of the world....Let your light so shine before men that they may see your moral excellence and your praiseworthy, noble and good deeds, and recognize and honor and praise and glorify your Father Who is in heaven. Matthew 5:14a,16 (Amplified Bible)*

Last November, while participating in the annual Christian Education Convention held at Grace Christian College (GCC), Dr. James Tan, President of GCC, stopped me and bounced off an amazing idea...a partnership project to coincide with their 60<sup>th</sup> Anniversary: mobilize 60 new churches to teach Biblical values in public schools and GCC would underwrite the cost of training and curriculum. “Let’s call it Lamp Lighters.” This began a series of phone calls, emails, and meetings which led to the signing of a Memorandum of Understanding. On April 16, more than 120 volunteers from 30+ churches converged at GCC for the one-day basic training (see picture below). To date 15 churches are now teaching Biblical values in 14 public schools and 4 private schools! Another 13 churches hope to start soon. Over the next two months, we hope to mobilize more churches to bring the number to a total of 60.

Praise God with us for Dr. Tan’s vision and investment and for those churches who are already (or are in process of) being lighted lamps in public schools. Thank you for allowing me to continue to serve here through your prayers and financial support. I am blessed by your most recent generous gift of \$1.500 in July. As partners together in this lamp-lighting ministry, many students are being exposed to the truths of God’s Word. We thank God for you.

Continue to pray for the hundreds of volunteers entering public schools each week with God’s Word—sharing, proclaiming, singing and shining the truth and love of the Lord Jesus Christ. May many see what God is doing and give Him praise.
