KEYNOTE SPEAKERS



Don Carson is research professor of New Testament at Trinity Evangelical Divinity School in Deerfield, Ill and former academic dean of Northwest Theological College in Richmond, BC. In addition to his extensive international itinerant ministry he has authored or edited over 50 books. Carson is an active guest lecturer in academic and church settings around the world. He is a member of the Tyndale Fellowship for Biblical Research, the Society of Biblical Literature, the Evangelical Theological Society, the Canadian Society of Biblical Studies, and the Institute for Biblical Research. Carson and his wife, Joy, reside in Libertyville, Illinois and have two children.



Mike Bullmore served for 15 years as associate professor of Homiletics and Pastoral Theology at Trinity Evangelical Divinity School in Deerfield, Ill as well as chairman of the Practical Theology Department. In 1998, he led the launch of CrossWay Community Church in Bristol, WI where he currently serves as senior pastor. Mike, a Kenosha, WI native, lives in his childhood home with his wife, Beverly, and their three children, Abigail, Madeline and Graham.

John Mahaffey is lead pastor of West Highland Baptist Church in Hamilton, ON. Prior to this he served with SEND International in the Philippines where he led two church planting teams of foreign and national workers. After returning to Canada he led the pastoral team of Morningstar Christian Fellowship in Toronto for 18 years.
