1. As you think about God's saving power that sanctifies us, consider the testimonies of our baptismal candidates and discuss what evidences of God's power in their lives was shared in their stories. What stood out for you? What can you identify with?
2. Read Ephesians 1:18-23. Verse 18 speaks of the eyes of our hearts being enlightened. What do you do to improve your spiritual eye sight?
3. What do you think of when you ponder God's power as it was displayed in the resurrection of Jesus?
4. From Ephesians 1: 21 – 22, God's power is displayed in Christ's Enthronement and having all things placed under His feet. Read also Matthew 11:27, Matthew 28:18, Philippians 2: 9 - 10, Colossians 2:10, I Peter 3:22, and Revelations 4: 1-11. Please reflect on some of your personal fears and concerns, and how these passages might help you deal with them?
5. What comfort do you find in knowing that Christ is now seated at the right hand of the Father? What does Scripture saying He is doing there? (Hebrews 7:25, Matt. 16:18, Hebrews 9:24, 1 Jn 2:1-2, others?)
6. At the 11 am service, William Cochran testified to the fear of the demonic. Pastor John also mentioned the fear of failing. What comfort does the resurrection of Jesus bring to these?
7. In the passage, we see God's power in part manifested through creation and through the resurrection of Christ. How can we as believers better appropriate God's power practically in our lives to not only grow in Christ, but also to battle evil that constantly surrounds us? (As reference, see Ephesians 4:27, Ephesians 6:10 – 20)
