***The Climax of the Gospel: Gal. 3:26-29***

1. What specifically are the results of our being united to Christ? How does Paul describe Christians in the verses?
2. Through faith we are the “sons of God”? What does this imply about our status? Why does Paul not use the word children instead of sons?
3. What does "sonship" mean to you? How could/should this change how we live day-to-day?
4. Consider the implications of baptism, as described here in verse 27. What does it mean that we are “clothed with Christ”? What does this idea of clothing ourselves with Christ imply? In what way does this phrase describe a whole new way of life?
5. In verse 28 Paul points out that we are not just united to Christ but also are part of a new community. What are the outstanding features of this community? What kinds of barriers are broken down in the fellowship of the church? Do you see this as a reality in West Highland? What steps can we as a church family do to break down these barriers? What can **you** do to see this become a reality among us?
6. How can we be more intentional about community-life within West Highland? Share your suggestions with a Ministry Team member.
7. By belonging to Christ we also belong to someone else. Who? What is the importance of this spiritual connection? What does this connect make us?
