1. What was the highlight of the Sunday morning activities for you?
2. What did you learn from the reports about children's programs at WH and what effect do you think the giving to the building campaign will have on our kids?
3. Did the greeting from David Sweet surprise you, coming from a government official? How can we as Christians ensure that people like David know we are supporting them in their work in Ottawa? What steps could you/the church take in finding/supporting Christians in government?
4. Read the following verses and share how we as believers can pray for our leaders and the issues our government should be addressing:

**1 Timothy 2:1-4**

**Romans 13:1**

**Jeremiah 29:7**

**1 Peter 2:17**

**2 Chronicles 7:14**

**Proverbs 21:1**

**Psalms 22:28**

5. What did you think of the apocryphal story about Noah?

6. Read Ephesians 4: 1 – 16 and discuss what should characterize the people of God who come together within the confines of a physical building? Consider the different gifts of the Spirit that God apportions to each person – can you identify which of the mentioned gifts in this passage relate to West Highland today and give an example of each?
  
7. Read 1 Kings 8:27-30 and 1 Cor. 6:19 and discuss the role of the building in our continuing efforts to get the Gospel out to our community.
  
8. What is the primary objective of the Church and the church? How is/can this be accomplished in your life? In what ways is West Highland focussing on this objective? Thinking through the planned expansion, how can the additions/changes contribute to this objective?
  
9. And all that we do, say or think it is because of the Faithfulness and Grace of God in our lives. Please read Ephesians 4: 1 – 16 and discuss what should characterize the people of God who come together within the confines of a physical building?
